

The project replaces the former Harris Academy.

The entire school was moved to alternative accommodation due to the tightness of the site and the requirement to build the school on the footprint of the existing building.

The site was steeply sloping, which required innovative solutions in respect to the form and layout of the structure.

The new school accommodates 1200 pupils over four levels with a capability of offering community use of internal sports facilities outside teaching hours.
